

## Attention Residents

May 23, 2016

1. On May 9, 2016 the Chester County Commissioners signed a resolution that all customers entering Chester County Convenience Centers must have a Chester County license plate. This will go in to effect July 1, 2016.
2. If your vehicle has out of county tag or out of state license plate you should contact the Chester County Clerk's Office and pay the wheel taxes. They will issue you a Chester County sticker for your license plate.
3. Chester County DOES NOT ACCEPT out of county Solid Waste or Construction and Demolition.
4. Part two of the resolutions states all contractors, commercial haulers, and peddlers must go through the scale house and pay the tipping fees. The scale operator will direct you to the correct containers.
5. Chester County Convenience Centers are for household solid waste only. Contractors, Commercial haulers, and peddlers are not allowed to dump in these centers. Commercial haulers, Contractors, and peddlers are not allowed to dump on weekends.
6. Tennessee law says you must register your vehicle in the county you reside in. Solid Waste disposal is expensive, and we do not want to use the solid waste budget to pay for solid waste from other counties.
